



Insight into the management of the inventory.

FEATURES

- › Integration of hardware and software information from various client management systems, IT inventory systems, and software roll-out tools.
- › Possibility to trigger data imports and synchronizations either automatically or manually.
- › Possibility to filter data prior to the import into CMDB.
- › For all changes made to inventory data, the inventory function can automatically create change tickets for documentation purposes.

The following product-specific back-ends are available:

- › baramundi
- › generic DB back-end (for OCS Inventory, for example)
- › opsi

HOW COULD IT BE USED?

KIX Pro (version 17) CMDB is already being used, but the inventory data is being maintained manually. This is a time-consuming process, and means the data is not always up to date.

A client management system such as opsi is being used in parallel with KIX Pro CMDB. The use of the add-on feature means selected data on the installed software and hardware (e.g. details about the CPU, RAM, hard drives of PC workstation systems) can be read out of the client management system. This data is then transferred automatically to KIX Pro CMDB.
